
### Korean Alphabets Practice with Soo

받침(batchim) should be put at the bottom and pronounced at the end of Korean syllable block. When writing, you can use all 19 con sonants and mixed consonants for 받침 but they can have only 7 sounds [ㄱ,ㄴ,ㄷ,ㄹ,ㅁ,ㅂ,ㅇ] which are k, n,t,l,m,p,ng.


